### **NOTIFICATION**

No. IPH.A (3) 10/95-Dated Shimla-2, the 23.8.96.

In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor, Himachal Pradesh, is pleased to make the Recruitment and Promotion Rules for the post of Jamadar Head Office Shimla / Dharamsala Class-IV (Non-Gazetted) in Irrigation and Public Health Department, as per Annexure-1 appended to this notification namely: -

**SHORT TITLE AND  
PRadesh,  
COMMENCEMENT:**

- I. (1) These rules may be called Himachal Department of Irrigation and Public Health Jamadar (Class-1V, Non-Gazetted) Recruitment and Promotion Rules, 1996.
- (2) These rules shall come into force from the date of Publication in Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh.

**REPEAL & SAVINGS:.**

- (2) (1) The Recruitment and Promotion Rules for the post of Class-IV service of Himachal Pradesh & Public Works Department as notified vide Notification No.1-59/71-PWA dt.22.9.73 and made applicable to the Irrigation and Public Health Department vide Notification No.PBW-2 B(13) 20/84 dated 27.4.94 are hereby repealed to the extent these are applicable to the post of Jamadar in Irrigation and Public Health Department.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal any appointment made of any thing done or

action taken under the relevant rules so repealed under Rule 2 (1) supra shall be deemed to have been validly done or taken under these rules.

Knowledge of customs manners and dialects of Himachal Pradesh and Suitability for appointment in the peculiar Conditions prevailing in the Pradesh.
8. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of the promotees: Age: Not applicable.

9. Period of probation, if any: Two years subject to such further extension for a period not exceeding

not exceeding one year as may be ordered by the competent authority in special circumstances and reasons to be recorded in writing.

10. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion, deputation, transfer and the percentage of vacancies to be filled in by various methods:

100 % by promotion.

11. In case of recruitment by promotion, deputation, transfer, grade from which transfer is to be made.

By appointment from amongst Peons Working under Head Office & its attached offices with at least three years regular Service or regular combined with continuous adhoc service (rendered upto 31.3.91 if any in the grade..

1. In all cases of promotion, the adhoc service rendered in the feeder post upto 31.3.91, if any, prior to regular appointment to the post shall be taken into account towards the length of service as prescribed in these rules for promotion subject to the conditions: -

(i) that in all cases where a junior person becomes eligible for consideration by virtue of his total length of service (including the service rendered on adhoc basis upto 31.3.91) in the feeder post in view of the provisions referred to above, all persons senior to him in the respective category / post / cadre shall be deemed to be eligible for consideration and placed above the junior persons in the field of consideration;

Provided that all incumbents to be considered for promotion shall possess the minimum qualifying service of at least three years or that prescribed in the recruitment and promotion rules for the post, whichever is less:

Provided further that where a person becomes ineligible to be considered for promotion on account of the recruitments of the proceedings proviso, the person(s) junior to him shall also be deemed to be ineligible for consideration for such promotion.

Explanation:- The last proviso shall not render the junior incumbents ineligible for consideration for promotion if the senior

ineligible persons happened to be Ex-servicemen recruited under the provisions of Rules-3 of Demobilized Armed Forces Personnel (Reservation of vacancies in Himachal Pradesh State Non-Technical Services) Rules, 1972 and having been given the benefit of seniority there under; or recruited under the provision of Rule-3 Ex-Serviceman (Reservation of vacancies in the Himachal Pradesh technical service) Rule, 1985 and having been given the benefit of seniority there under.

(2) Similarly, in all cases of confirmation adhoc service rendered on the feeder post upto 31.3.91, if any, prior to the regular appointment against such post shall be taken into account towards the length of service,

Provided that inter-se-seniority as a result of confirmation after taking into account, adhoc service rendered upto 31.3.91 shall remain unchanged.
