## Minutes of the Video Conference with the Chief Engineer, Superintending Engineers & Executive Engineers of Dharamshala Zone held on 23.9.2013.

A Video Conference to review the functioning of the works of Dharamshala Zone, IPH Department was held under the Chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary (IPH) on 23.09.2013.

Additional Chief Secretary (IPH) to the GoHP welcomed all the participants and emphasized upon the need to accelerate the pace of work to achieve the targets for the current financial year-2013-14. He urged that regular supervision by all field officers / officials should be undertaken so that works are completed in a time bound manner and reiterated the need of regular touring and Inspection notes at all levels. He further emphasized that under all programmes the target fixed would be monitored on a monthly basis as per 'Target Sheets' and the annual assessment of the performance of every individual officer will purely be based on it.

#### New Agenda Item (2) Physical & Financial achievements upto 31.8.2013.

The physical and financial progress to achieve the targets for the year 2013-14 under all sectors was reviewed. The over all physical & financial progress made under Water Supply sector is satisfactory but there is a shortfall in achievement under irrigation sector in respect of SNP Circle, Fatehpur, Chamba and Nurpur Circles. - (iii) Each Executive Engineer would motivate one KVA/WSA per sub- Division to take this responsibility.

## i) Salli to Dairni Rirkumar, Hathor Kuhl will be constructed.

The Superintending Engineer, I&PH Circle, Dharamshala informed that the DPR for improvement of FIS Darini Kuhl, has been prepared and sent to Additional Chief Secretary (IPH) to the Govt. of HP. vide letter No. IPH-P&I-II-EE(M)- RIDF-XIX/2013-14- 2310-13 dated 4.10.2013 for approval/ funding under NABARD (RIDF-XIX).

The Chairman expressed concern on 87 ongoing schemes >3 to <5 years old out of which 61 schemes are of Chamba and 23 schemes of Nurpur Circles and remaining 3 schemes relate to Dharamshala. The Additional Chief Secretary (IPH) directed S.E. Chamba/ S.E. Nurpur and Executive Engineer Jawali to complete/close such ongoing schemes.

#### Point No. 7:- Drilling of Hand Pumps with portable Rigs at off road locations-

The Engineer-in-Chief (IPH) directed all E.Es to follow the instructions already conveyed vide letter dated 13.9.2013 with regard to adding the condition of drilling 10% hand pumps at off road sites/locations in the tenders which are yet to be finalized. The C.E. (D/Z) pointed out that short listed Firms are not participating/interested in installation of hand pumps at off road locations. It was therefore, decided that other Firms can also be allowed to participate in the tenders. The progress shall be intimated **by 15 Nov., 2013.** 

#### Point No. 8:- Activities of WSSO

Online entries on IMIS module on the following format:

• Lab tests & FTK tests :

The position of online entries in IMIS module on the all prescribed formats was reviewed and the progress made in this regard is satisfactory.

#### • Trainings:-

There is a huge gap in target and achievement upto the month of 8/2013. The Director (WSSO) emphasized the need to make all out efforts to achieve the targets.

#### • Status of various Laboratories.

The Director (WSSO) pointed out that there is duplication in entry of laboratory which is required to be corrected and asked the concerned S.E. to get the same corrected.

#### • Information regarding Division-wise engagement of Jal Rakshaks :-

The information regarding requirement of Jal Rakshaks to be deployed for operation of schemes in respect of Dharamsala Zone has not received. The Superintending Engineers/Executive Engineers concerned were directed by the Engineer-in-Chief, to send the requirement by <u>15<sup>th</sup> November, 2013.</u>

#### Point No.9: Projects under AIBP

#### (i). Major Irrigation project Shahnehar:

The Chief Engineer (D/Z) informed that there was a target under RBC of Minors works for 0.5056 KMs up to August, 2013 which has been achieved fully during the month of June 2013. Another target of 2.225 KMs was for Sub minor works i.e. RCC pipes of RBC. Same has been completed during May 2013. Also there was a target of 2.225 KMs for water courses of open channel RBC. This has been achieved fully during June 2013. The work of the project has been completed during June, 2013.

In case the CCA is less as per norms, the project can be taken up under Minor Irrigation sector.

The concerned Superintending Engineer were directed to resubmit the pending DPRs immediately and reiterated the instructions already issued during the course of previous meeting in this regard.

#### (iii) Status of Non-Starter projects:-

There is no Non Starter Project under Dharamshala Zone.

#### (iv) Slow moving projects:-

There are 49 slow moving projects relating to Dharamshala Zone ( 8 Chamba+12 Nurpur + 29 Dharamshala). CE (Dharamshala Zone) and SEs concerned accelerate the pace of work to get these projects out of slow moving category immediately. The E-in-Chief (IPH) observed that there is a general inclination amongst the EEs to expend NRDWP funds in comparison to state funds, and , to utilize the SCSP in the current financial year. Detailed instructions have been issued by the Govt. vide letter No. IPH-B©1-1/2012 dated 27.09.2013 to the E-in-C, IPH , all Chief Engineers and DCs after convening a meeting with ACS (SJ&E) to GoHP and, these must be followed strictly and funds must be utilized effectively to complete those schemes which are 75% complete on priority after seeking reappropriation. The scheme wise status of slow moving project is as **per Annexure 10(c). All SEs will report compliance.** 

#### Point No. 11- Status of Preparation of DPRs under MLA priority schemes for the year 2013-14:-

The Additional Chief Secretary (IPH) expressed dissatisfaction on the progress made in preparation of DPRs. All Superintending Engineers/Executive Engineers were directed to assess the feasibility of proposed schemes /time schedule for preparation of DPRs and to submit the same by <u>15<sup>th</sup> October, 2013</u> and simultaneously submit the DPRs of feasible irrigation schemes and drinking water water supply schemes as per agreed dates.
