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MINUTES OF THE 2ND MEETING OF SCREENING COMMITTEE HELD ON 18-09-2015 UNDER THE CHAIRPERSONSHIP OF HON'BLE IPH MINISTER FOR PROCUREMENT OF GI/DI/ HDPE PIPES, AND GI WIRE.

The agenda items were deliberated in detail and following decisions were taken:-

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ITEM NO.1. COMPLAINT AGAINST M/S TIRPUPATI CONTAINERS PVT. LTD.,

The contents of the complaint were discussed in detail and Committee found that there has been considerable delay in supplying of pipes by M/S Tirupati Containers Pvt. Ltd. The representative of HP State Civil Supplies Corporation informed the committee that the material has reached consignee's destination after a long gap from the date of dispatch which the Committee members felt is a matter of great concern and should be looked into. The committee approved the proposal that the technical representative of IPH Department be also sent for inspection to each firms premises to ensure quality and to obviate delay in delivery of material. The Committee also agreed to I&PH Department's proposal that HP State Civil Supplies Corporation may seek copies of form-26 from each truck carrying the material to check pilferage. Also the Committee approved that the Civil Supplies Corporation should release payment of Sales Tax / VAT and excise duty on pipes on receipt of documentary proof of its actual payment to eliminate tax evasion by the firms.

The Committee decided to seek prior information from the firms in case of transshipment and the HP State Civil Supplies Corporation representative should be present during transshipment.

ITEM NO. 2. GI PIPES:-

The matter was discussed in detail and the Committee approved procurement of 12965 MT of priority-1 G.I. Pipes as the same were received from Zonal Chief Engineers. The procurement from the L-1 firms were approved and where L-1 firm has shown its inability to supply full quantity within delivery period then from L-2 / L-3 and so on consenting firms on L-1 matching negotiated Rail Head rates, recommended by I&PH Department based on Raw Material Rates of August, 2015 i.e. HR Coil @ Rs.27050/- PMT and Zinc @ Rs.141011 PMT, as per the following details:-

ITEM NO. 4. HDPE PIPES

The Screening Committee considered and approved the requirement of 6050 RMT of HDPE pipes of various classes and sizes and its procurement on valid HPCOS Rate Contract Rates.

ITEM NO. 5. GI Wire:-

The Screening Committee considered and approved the requirement of 300 MT of GI Wire and its procurement on conclusion of HPCOS Rate Contract Rates.

ITEM NO. 6. EXTENSION CASES:-

The cases of extension of delivery period of various firms were deliberated upon by the members of the Committee. The members expressed concern about inordinate delay in supply of GI pipes by various firms. The Committee opined that stipulated delivery period should be strictly adhered to by the firms and the department should ensure timely supply of excise exemption certificate to the firms. The committee took notice of the observations of the representative of the Finance that the firm which caused inordinate delay in supply of pipes should be panelized as per contract with the firm. After detailed discussions, the Committee granted ex-post-facto approval for regularization of proposed extension in delivery period of various firms. However, the members were of the view that for future procurement, stringent action be taken against the firms.

7. ADDITIONAL AGENDA:-

The complaint was placed before the Screening Committee by the Member Secretary. The Members perused the contents of the complaint in detail. The Committee members were apprised that although centralized system of procurement of material is being followed in

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majority of cases, yet in some cases turnkey tenders are also being allowed. The detail of works where permission has not been taken in the last three years be put up for consideration of Screening Committee. The Committee desired that quality of material may be ensured in all such cases.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
