Rules for Enlistment of Contractors in H.P. Irrigation & Public Health Department-modification/addition thereof

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department Notification of even number dated 29-10-2013 on the subject cited above and to say that the Rules for Enlistment of Contractors in H.P. Irrigation & Public Health Department, 2013 were made applicable w.e.f. 1-11-2013 Subsequently, one renewal was allowed to those contractors/firms which were already enlisted under the old enlistment rules as a one time relaxation in Enlistment Rules, 2013 vide letter of even number dated 29-08-2014.

- A number of representations from Contractors/firms have been received through O/o Hon'ble Chief Minister, H.P. and Hon'ble 1&PH-Minister, H.P. to resolve the issues of their re-validation in the I&PH Department. After careful examination of the matter and to resolve the issues raised by the Contractors/Firms, Rule 19 of the Rules for Enlistment of Contractors in H.P. Irrigation & Public Health Department, 2013 is hereby modified as per Annexure-A in pursuance to the provision of Rule 25 of the Rules ibid for immediate adoption..
- Sr. No. 19 of the application form for enlistment as Contractors for all the classes is also amended as under:-

"The Applicant should give an under taking that before the commencement of any work he will comply with the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation of Abolition) H.P. Rule; 1974, provisions of H.P. Building & Other construction workers (Regulation of employment & conditions of service) rules, 2008 as amended from time to time. The applicant should also submit an undertaking at the time of enlistment that he will obtain EPF/ESIS registration before commencement of any work awarded to him/her. However, no work shall be awarded before the Contractor submitthe EPF/ESIS registration

This may be brought to the notice of the all concerned for strict mpliance and also be uploaded on the website of I&PH Department.

Rule-19 of the existing Rules for Enlistment of Contractors in H.P. Irrigation & Public Health Department as Notified vide Government Notification No. IPH-B(C)17-4/2008-1 dated 29-10-2013 is modified as under:

Revalidation of enlistment – The validity of initial enlistment of the contractor shall be as given in Para-7. It shall, however, be revalidated on merits, if desired by the contractor. Only the contractors who have secured some work(s) (see para 24 also) of appropriate magnitude* in H. P. IPH Department / State Government Departments / Central Government Departments/ Central Autonomous Bodies/State Autonomous Bodies / Central Public Sector Undertakings/ State Public Sector Undertakings (with documentary proof) shall be considered for revalidation

The revalidation shall be done for the period as detailed below:-

Category A, B₁ C & D:- Enlistment of such contractors who satisfy the following criterion shall be sonsidered for revalidation for a period of 3 years.

- (I) Securing two works of appropriate magnitude* during last enlistment/revalidation period and at least one of them has been completed 80% and the second completed more than 40%.
- (II) Enlistment of contractors, who secured only one work of appropriate magnitude* during last enlistment/revalidation period and that even not completed, shall be extended for a period of two years. Revalidation for the balance period of one year shall be granted, only when the contractor satisfies the criteria laid down in (I) above.
- (III) A contractor can submit application for revalidation if he fulfills all the eligibility criteria provided he has participated in tendering process in HP Irrigation & Public Health Department of appropriate magnitude* but remained second lowest or third lowest at least on 2 occasions (with documentary proof) during the validity period of his enlistment.
- (IV) A contractor who fails to revalidate his enlistment on due date can submit fresh application for enlistment if he fulfills all the eligibility criteria provided he has participated in the tendening process in HP Irrigation & Public Health Department of appropriate magnitude* but

- remained second lowest or third lowest on more than 2 occasions (with documentary proof) during the validity period of his enlistment.
- (V) Minimum work done during period of enlistment / previous revalidation required to comply with the provision of kule 19 above while submitting application for revalidation;

Provided that in case of a Contractor enlisted with I&PH Department exclusively for drilling of Hand Pumps and Bore Wells/Tube Wells, minimum work done during period of enlistment / previous revalidation required to comply with the provisions of Rule 19 above while submitting application for revalidation will be as under-
