Subject:- Chlorination campaign.

Cases of Jaundice are being reported in Shimla town by the local press for the last fortnight and it is being alleged that the outbreak of the disease could be attributed to LWSS Ashwani Khad. Further, summer season is also likely to set in shortly and some sources of water supply may be contaminated during this period. The people residing in certain higher areas /tail end of schemes/ uncovered areas resort to drinking untreated water resulting in water borne diseases. In order to prevent/curb such incidents, it is necessary to take due precautions like ensuring proper and regular chlorination and spreading message to consumers to drink only treated water. Furthermore, the protocol of water sample testing in the laboratories besides testing of residual chlorine at consumer end may be religiously followed and monitored at all levels.

It is therefore, reiterated that necessary instructions in this regard issued vide this office letter No. IPH-PH- Chlorination /2012-760-79 dated 17th May, 2012 may be brought home to all field staff and followed in letter & spirit.
