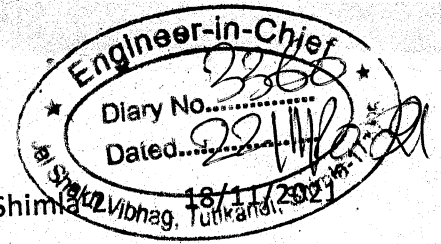

Notification

Consequent to the recommendations of 7<sup>th</sup> State Level Technical Committee, the Governor, HP is pleased to modify the eligibility & qualification criteria in tendering process of Jal Shakti Vibhag as under:-

Eligibility & Qualification Criteria:

A) For works equal to or above INR 5.00 crore:

- i) Average Annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31<sup>st</sup> March of the previous financial year, should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.
- ii) Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:-
  - a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.  
or
  - b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.  
or
  - c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimate cost.
- iii) Definition of "similar work" should be clearly defined in the tender document by the DNIT approving authority. In addition, the criteria regarding satisfactory performance of works, personnel, establishment, plant, equipment etc. may be incorporated according to the requirement of the Project.

The following note be incorporated in the bid documents:

- i) The value of executed works shall be brought to current price level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum calculated from the date of completion of works to previous day of last day of submission of bids.
- ii) Completed work means either completed or completed to the extent of minimum 90% of awarded amount (including unpaid amount on a/c of paucity of funds).
- iii) The certificate in this regard be obtained on the format as prescribed in the Notice Inviting Tender.
- iv) For works above INR 5.00 Crore, the contractor enlisted with Jal Shakti Vibhag (erstwhile IPH) or any other Govt./Semi-Govt. Departments/Autonomous bodies as per his/her class of enlistment should be allowed.

**B) For works equal to or less than INR 5 Crore**

- i) For all the works less than estimated cost of INR 5.00 Crore, contractor enlisted with Jal Shakti Vibhag (erstwhile IPH) only should be allowed. However, for specialized work within this category, the contractor enlisted with any other Govt./Semi-Govt. Departments/Organisation or Autonomous bodies as per his/her class of enlistment should also be allowed.
- ii) For specialized works within this category, the Engineer-in-Charge may define the Similar Work in accordance with the type of work and specifications. The definition of the Similar Works in such cases shall be approved by the next higher Authority.

**C) Requirements of the Experience Certificate:**

- i) To demonstrate experience of the similar work as per eligibility criteria, the bidder/contractor shall submit the certificate of similar work. Completed work means either completed or completed to the extent of minimum 90% of awarded amount (including unpaid amount on a/c of paucity of funds).
  - ii) It may be noted that the ultimate objective of tendering exercise is to encourage competition and reduce cost. Therefore; in the event of low participation in the 1<sup>st</sup> call i.e. two or less tenderers, tenders should be re-called. However, in 2<sup>nd</sup> call, in case of single participation/ tenderer, tenders should be recalled and in case of two tenderers, if quite justifiable, tender can be awarded to the L-1, Further, in case of poor response or un-reasonably high offers are received even after calling the tenders twice, it is prudent to throw open tenders to next lower class including to the contractors registered with other departments of the State, with other State Governments and with Govt. of India. NIT approving authority may modify the eligibility criteria suitably with full justification and their vision must not be with a view to facilitate the entry of particular contractor/firm. The prior approval of the next higher authority will be mandatory.
- Remarks* iii) The DNIT shall be prepared for both categories prescribed above and tender shall be floated at the 100% amount of the estimated cost/technical sanction amount instead of 75%.

Consequent to the recommendations of 7<sup>th</sup> State Level Technical Committee as emanating from the CVC guidelines issued vide Notification No. 12-02-I-CTE-6, dated 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2002 and as per the Model Tender Document for Procurement of Non Consultancy Service circulated by Govt. of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure dated 29-10-2021, the Governor, HP is pleased to modify the eligibility & qualification criteria in tendering process of Jal Shakti Vibhag as under:-

**Eligibility & Qualification Criteria:**

**A) For works equal to or above INR 5.00 crore:**

- F.R. EIC J.C. CTR. 25/11/21*
- i) Average Annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31<sup>st</sup> March of the previous financial year, should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.
  - ii) Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:-
    - a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.  
or
    - b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.  
or
    - c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimate cost.
  - iii) Definition of "similar work" should be clearly defined in the tender document by the DNIT approving authority. In addition, the criteria regarding satisfactory performance of works, personnel, establishment, plant, equipment etc. may be incorporated according to the requirement of the Project.

**The following note be incorporated in the bid documents:**

**B) For works equal to or less than INR 5 Crore**

- i) For all the works less than estimated cost of INR 5.00 Crore, contractor enlisted with Jal Shakti Vibhag (erstwhile IPH) only should be allowed. - ii) It may be noted that the ultimate objective of tendering exercise is to encourage competition and reduce cost. Therefore, in the event of low participation in the 1<sup>st</sup> call i.e. two or less tenderers, tenders should be re-called. However, in 2<sup>nd</sup> call, in case of single participation/ tenderer, tenders should be recalled and in case of two tenderers, if quite justifiable, tender can be awarded to the L-1, Further, in case of poor response or un-reasonably high offers are received even after calling the tenders twice, it is prudent to throw open tenders to next lower class including to the contractors registered with other departments of the State, with other State Governments and with Govt. of India.
