II The State Water Quality Review Committee shall undertake amongst other the following activities:-

- (i) To review water quality(WQ) monitoring net work in the respective regions for optimization in terms of location of stations, frequency of monitoring the choice of parameters.
  - i) To review water quality data analysis interpretation order to identify the problem areas and developing Action Plans for improving quality on sustainability basis.
- (iii) To review/assess schemes launched/ to be launched improved quality of the water resources.

o identify hot spots for surveillance monitoring.

promote R & D activities.

To share water quality data and provide assistance to the member agencies in the management of the quality of national water resources, and

ii Any other responsibility as may be assigned the WQRC by the Authority/ State Government contact of quality of the national water resources.

III. The committee may examine & discuss specific WQ related task to be carried out and recommend the mode of executing such tasks e.g. by constituting small task groups, using state of central agency resources or by hiring WQ domsin experts.

IV. The Committee shall submit quarterly report every three months to the WQAA commencing from September, 2002 so that the same may be reflected in the annual report for the authority.

V The WQRC may evolve its own procedure for carrying out the above activities.
